OVERARCHING GOAL


Enhance and ensure the relevance and reach of our transformational programming for youth.

The AYF subsidizes tuition for ALL participants each year with an average 37% reduction in cost per child.

> The AYF scholarships are given for an **average of 6 years**, ensuring a long-term relationship and growth in the program.
